

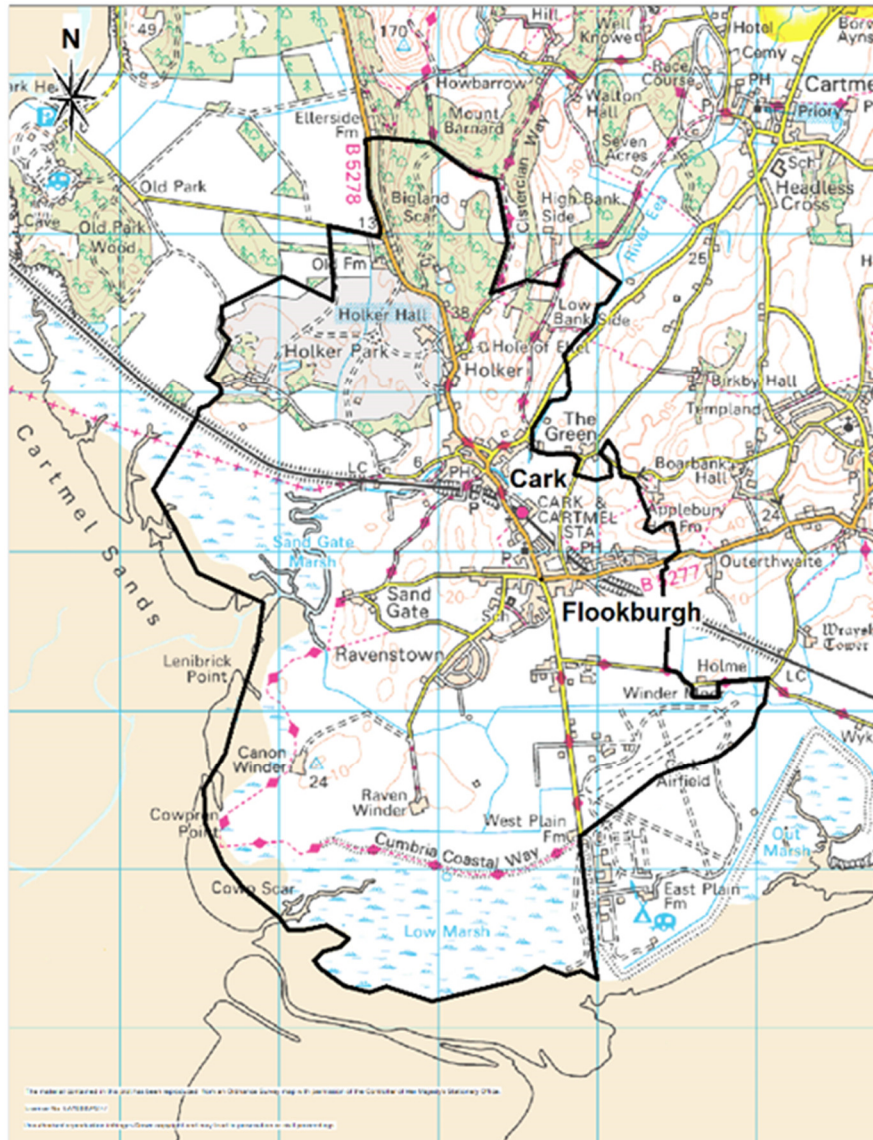
Public Watering Place Charity
